Opinion

We did not audit the annual financial statements of one foreign subsidiary included in the Statement, whose financial information reflects total assets of Rs.418.08 lakhs as at 31st March, 2023, total revenues of Rs.Nill, total net profit after tax of Rs.24.44 lakhs and total comprehensive loss of Rs.248.12 lakhs, and cash flows (net) of Rs.1,417.35 lakhs for the year ended on that date, as considered in the Statement. These annual financial statements have been audited by other auditors whose audit reports have been furnished to us by the management, and our conclusion in so far as it relates to the amounts and disclosures included in respect of this subsidiary is based solely on the audit reports of such other auditors and the procedures performed by us as stated in paragraph 11 above. Our opinion is not modified in respect of this matter with respect to our reliance on the work done by and the reports of other auditors.
- 13. The Statement includes the consolidated financial results for the quarter ended 31st March, 2023, being the balancing figures between the audited consolidated figures in respect of the full financial year and the published unaudited year-to-date consolidated figures up to the third quarter of the current financial year, which were subject to limited review by us.
